# Curl at Niagara Falls this season for \$125.00!!!

New members to the NFCC will be able to curl for the first half of the season for only \$125.00 plus HST. You can curl in as many leagues as you wish. In December you will be asked if you would like to continue on, and if so, you will be charged for the balance of the season at a special rate available to our new and returning members.

New Members are defined as any person who were not a member for the 2018-2019 curling season.

### Membership rates:

To curl once per week:

- \$141.25 including HST due at the beginning of the season.
- \$238.75 including HST due Jan. 1, 2020 if you decide to continue for the balance of the season.

To curl more than once per week:

- \$141.25 including HST due at the beginning of the season.
- \$408.75 including HST due on January 1, 2020 if you decide to continue for the balance of the season.

If you decide not to continue for the second half of the season there are no further commitments.

Also included is a free instruction clinic at the beginning of the season so you can freshen up your skills, and you can participate in a special Rookie Spiel in the fall for a nominal fee.

without a huge financial outlay!!**

## FAQ's

### 1. I had an injury so I would not be able to deliver the rock.

No problem! Many curlers that have developed bad knees or hips over the years, have continued curling with a throwing stick. Dozens of NFCC members use them now regularly and they are becoming one of the fastest growing methods of curling in the game! It is widely accepted! The OCA has even developed a Provincial Competition for stick players only. There will be free instruction available on the use of the "stick", and they are available to use with the club brooms on the ice free of charge.



### 2. How do I get placed on a team?

The club is blessed with a great group of volunteer league organizers who will help you. Some leagues are set up to sign up individually and you are then placed on a team. Others are set up as a "team entry". Once you have expressed an interest in playing in one of these leagues, the league organizer will endeavour to have you placed on a team. There are almost always teams looking for players.

### 3. I am not good enough to play on the competitive nights:

Yes you are! Our competitive leagues are mostly flighted, so they have curlers of all abilities. As your team improves, you are moved up to another flight. Generally, you are playing teams of equal ability.

**4. I work shift work and can't commit.**

Sure you can!! You can be placed on a team as a fifth player. Then you can work out with your team when you are available. Many teams face times when they are short a player due to work, vacation or illness and they need a fifth player regularly! Alternatively, you could also be asked to be placed on a spare list so that you can curl when asked, by any team.

**5. Is there instruction available for me?**

There will be free instruction available at the club in the first week of curling. There are also many ongoing clinics you can sign up for throughout the season for a nominal fee.

**6. I don't have any equipment.**

All you need to get started is a warm jacket, a pair of gloves, stretchy slacks and a clean pair of flat soles running shoes you would bring to the club to change into. The club will provide the rest. There are brooms and/or throwing sticks in the curling rink and tape at the bar to put on your shoes all free of charge. If you would like to update your equipment, the club has a well stocked pro shop that offers a variety of curling supplies at reasonable prices.

**7. I go away for a part of the season.**

Then try our offer for the first part of the season for \$125.00 then let us know you will not be returning at Christmas. If you enjoyed it, next season, you can purchase a half year membership if you want to try it again!

**8. What days/nights can I curl?**

There is curling offered just about every day at the NFCC, as well as several in club fun bonspiels you are welcome to participate in. A complete listing is available on the NFCC website.

**9. Can I use my credit card to pay for my dues?**

Absolutely! The club accepts Master Card and Visa.

**10. I am a student or have just graduated and getting started in my career and curling will be expensive for me.**

We have a special Student and Intermediate Membership categories that allow younger curlers to join our club at a discounted price.

**11. I would just like to curl a couple of times a month or so.**

Join our Sunday Sinners League at a price of \$185.00 for the season!

**12. I just want to curl once per week.**

A one draw per week membership is available at a discounted price.
